- 3. Aims and Objects: The aim and objects for which the society is established are as under:



The Governing Body of the society may refuse any person for the membership provided the Governing Body roords the reason for a such refusal.

2.1 GOVERNING BODY/ELECTION:

The management of the affairs of the society and its investments and the powers of deployment, allotment, payment and the disbursement of it funds and properties shall vest in the Governing Body. The Governing Body shall consist of not less than Body of the members who shall be elected by the General the mode of election.

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2.2 TERM OF GOVERNING BODIES MEMBERG:

The member of the Governing Body shall hold Office for a term of 5 Years of the society team the respective dates of their appointment and shall be eligible for re-appointment. Unless otherwise decided by the Governing Body, a member of the Governing Body shall continue to be in office after the expiry of his term until his successor has been appointed.

2.3 VACANCY OF GOVERNING BODY:

In case a member of the Governing Body resign dies, ceases to be a member or vacates office otherwise, the vacancy shall be fulfilled by the propriate appointing authority.

2.4 POWER OF THE GOVERNING BOOKS A

of the Governing Body to do such things as it may consider necessary or expedient for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the society. The Governing Body may exercise the following power.

a) OPEN BANK ACCOUNT:

In the name of the society with such Bank(s) or other institutions(s) as it may think fit, from time to time and authorise any two of its members of the society to operate such account(s).

- b) Defray the expenses of the society activities and make contribution from the function property of the society to any other Trust or July or Association having objects similar to those of the society.
- c) Invest/deposit such funds of the society as may not be immediately required in such menner as may be determined by the Board team time to time subject to any statutory restrictions and realise or vary such investments.
- d) Borrow moneys for the purpose of the society and if necessary, create lien on the society assets for the purpose.
- e) Appoint and, at the discretion, remove or suspend employees of all categories of the society and, from time to time, determine their power's and duties and fix their remuneration and terms of employment,



- f) Delegate any of its powers (including the power to sub-delegate) to such committees or sub-committees and as it may constitute consisting of such members or others and to any member of the Governing Body or office bearer of the society.
- g) Sell, improve, manage and develop all or any part of the property and rights of the society.
- h) Generally do such things as it may consider necessary or expedient for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the Society:

3.1 MEETING OF THE COVERNING BODY:

The Governing Body shall meet as and when a meeting is convened by the Chairman or is requisitioned by at least three members of the Governing Body provided that it shall meet atleast once in six calender months. OF S

3.2 NOTICE FOR MEETING:

At least seven days natice shall be given for a meeting of the Governing Body, but a nating may be called by the Chairman without any notice in case exigencies.

3.3 QUORUM FOR MEETING:

1/3rd members of the Governing Body, personally present shall from the quorum for a meeting of the Governing Body.

3.4 DECISIONS:

The Governing Body shall take decisions by a vote of the majority. Every member shall have one vote and in case of a tie, the Chairman of the meeting shall also have a casting vote.

3.5 RESOLUTION BY CIRULATION:

A resolution by the majority of the members of the Governing Body after circulation and staff the member for the time being in India, shall be an elective and binding as resolution passed at a meeting of the Governing Body.

4.1 OFFICE BEARERS:

The Society shallh have the following office bearers.

- 1 President.
- 2. Vice-President.
- 3. Secretary.
- 4. Joint-Secretary
- 5. Treasurer.
- 6. Xeoutive Members (Meximum no.7)

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The president of the Society shall be the President of the Governing Body and Vice-Verse. All the office bearers of the society shall be elected in the General Body meeting.

5.1 The office bearers as specified in clause 4.1 shall have the following powers/functions.

PRESIDENT:

He shall preside overall the meetings of General Body and Governing Body.

In case of equality of votes in any meeting he shall have a casting vote.

He shall supervise work of other office bearers.

VICE PRESIDENT:

During the absence of the president of shall take the Chair.

SECRETARY:

He shall represent the soddety. He shall keep and maintain all records including the register of members, minutes book etc. He shall undertake all types of correspondence. On behalf of the Society. He shall convene the meetings of General Body and Governing Body and shall also inform every member regarding the tim s, date, place etc. of the meetings.

He shall perform all other function as may be assigned to him.

TREASURER:

He shall collect subscriptions, gifts, grant, aids, donations etc from the members, general public and he shall also be responsible for keeping and maintaing of a due and correct account of the society.

JOINT-SECRETARY:

During the absence of the secretary, he shall take the chair of

6.1 FINANCIAL YEAR:

The amount of the society smallbe made up and prepared from 1st April to 31st March every year.

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7.1 AUDIT

The Society annual accounts shall be Audited by any Chartered Accountant appointed as Auditor of the Society.

8.1 There shall be General Body of the Society consisting of all the members of the society. The meetings of the society's General Body shall be held atleast once in a financial year. 1/3rd member shall be the quorum. No quorum shall be required in the adjourned meetings. An emergency meetings of the General Body may also be summoned on the written request of 3/5th members. A minimum notice of 7 days shall be required to convene the me ting of General Body.

- 8.2 EXTRA-ORDINARY MEETINGS:

An extra-ordinary general meeting of members may be called as and when required by the Governing Body or as requisitioned by members sufficient in number to constitute a quorum.

- 8.3 The provision applicable to Governing Body shall apply mutatis mutandis to general mutaings.
- 9.1 ANNUAL LIST:

Every year a list of Governing Body office bearers and members shall be filed in the office of Registrar of societies Delhi as required u/s 4 of SR. Act of 1860.

Any amendment in the memorandum or rules of this society shall be carried out in accordance with procedure laid down u/s 12 and 12 A of SR. Act of 1860.

11.1 LEGAL PROCEEDINGS:

The society may sue or be sued in the name of its president as required U/s 6 or SR.Act of 1860.

12.1 INCOME NOT TO REVERT:

The income of the society from its poperty or donations whatsoever derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the society as set out in its Memorandum of Association and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly to the persons who at any time are or have been members of the society or to any of them or any person claiming through any of them provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment in goods faith of remuneration to any person (including a member of the Governing Body) Called upon the perform some office or function for the society.

13.1 DISSOLUTION

The society may be dissolve in adordance with procedure laid down U/s 13 & 14 of SR Act of 1850.

14.1 EXCLUSION OF PERSONAL RESPONS TO ILITER

No member of the Governing Body shall be answerable or personally liable for any loss arising from the administration or application of the funds and properties of the society unless such loss or damage is caused through wilful default or breach of trust or culpable negligence on his part.

14.2 APPLICABILITY OF THE ACT.

All the provision of the societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 Act(Punjab Amendment) Act 1957, as extended to the Union Territory of Delhi, will apply to this Society.
